



## We'd like to thank you for being part of the Circuit Breaker with us.

It has been – and continues to be – a difficult and uncertain time for not only our mentees and their families, but also for us as mentors.

Nothing can stop us from continuing to connect. We have learnt how to stay engaged with our mentees via video conferencing. Zoom sessions are meaningful; relationships are strengthened; and we are learning new skills.

We've received many acts of kindness during this period:

- A donation of 250 surgical masks before the start of the Circuit Breaker
- A mentee formerly from The Tent donated 10 refurbished laptops using her own savings, despite having just graduated and without a job
- A 16-year-old student organised a Bake Sale and donated 50 reusable masks
- [HopeFull](#) donated boxes of home-based activities – Tinker Boxes – for children in [Families for Families](#) during the school holidays
- [Bridge The Digital Divide](#) donated refurbished laptops for students doing HBL and mentees looking to improve their skills for better jobs

Through the generosity of our friends and family, we raised \$29K within 10 days for an Emergency Fund to support our mentees and their families with groceries, baby formula, diapers, and more.

Now we hope to raise at least \$50,000 for the [Dream Fund](#) for mentees continuing their education.
